Kenjgewin Teg is an Anishnaabe controlled and directed education organization that strives to provide a comprehensive, qualitative, cultural and holistic approach to First Nations based education, training and services. Our vision is to give students the ability to see the gift they were given, in order to be able to succeed in this world!

We are currently seeking 25 youth between the ages of 16 and 24 years to participate in a four week Anishinaabek Youth Ambassador program. This program will cultivate youth leaders through cultural, personal and professional development.

Anishinaabek Youth Ambassadors – 25 participants

Salary: \$14.00 per hour, 30 hours a week

Program components will include leadership development, communication skills, culture based learning and professional development. The Anishinaabek Youth Ambassador Program will foster cultural resilience, cultural identity and self confidence that supports young leaders who are grounded in their identity by encompassing spiritual, intellectual, emotional and the physical well-being of the youth.

Eligibility:

- Must be between the ages of 16 and 24 years
- Willingness to learn and participate in the four different program components: Cultural Development, Personal Leadership, Communication Skills and Essential Skills
- Land Based Learning
- Experiential Learning
- Empowerment workshops
- Finding your voice and communication leadership skills
- Culture and language learning and Building your Personal Anishinabek Bundle teachings
- Anishinabek History
- Fun, laughter, sharing and learning
- Community Involvement and civic community civic engagement
- Final day will be a Youth Gathering of Sharing and Learning for family and Community
- Must participate for the four weeks
